TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR ~~SALE~~ OF CORRUGATED BOXES SCRAP MATERIAL AND POLYETHYLENE WRAPPING FILM LYING AT CLBP MEHATPUR & CLBP PARWANOO FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR 2025-26:

1. Tender should be sent in two sealed envelopes referring Technical Bid and Financial Bid and date of opening on the envelope along with sign and stamp on each page of terms and conditions as acceptance of the terms and conditions of the tender document. The tender will be opened on **18-06-2025** at **2:30 PM** in the presence of tenderers or their authorized representatives, if any, in the office of the Managing Director, H.P. General Industries Corporation Ltd, Himrus Building, Cart Road, Shimla-171 001.

Requirement of Technical Bid-


i) Earnest Money (ii) Affidavit of non blacklisting by any Govt. Deptt., Board, PSUs (Central or State) over India (iii) Acceptance of Terms & Conditions (iv) Copy of GST Registration (v) PAN / CIN (v) Authority letter in case of representatives (vi) Bank Account Number IFSC code alongwith cancelled cheque.

The Financial Bid will be opened of the tenderer who qualify the mandatory requirement of technical bid.

2. The tender must be accompanied with earnest money in the form of demand draft / RTGS/ NEFT in SBI A/c No. 55012850082 IFSCBIN0050118 in favour of HP General Industries Corporation Ltd payable at Shimla. However, the Corporation will not be liable to pay any interest thereon. No tender shall be accepted without the earnest money.
3. The schedule of lifting of scrap material will be given by the General Manager, CLBP Mehatpur and Manager CLBP Parwanoo as per availability of scrap material on weekly and monthly basis.
4. There should be no over writing. All cuttings/corrections must be signed, attested with the seal.
5. The tenderer should specifically declare as to whether his company/firm is registered under MSME, Act 2006 or not. If so, the tenderer is required to submit the Registration Certificate to this effect with the tender document.
6. The Managing Director of this Corporation reserves the right to accept/reject any/all tenders without assigning any reason.
7. Conditional, unsigned, late and delayed tender will not be considered/ entertained. In case, the date of opening happened to be holiday, the tender will be opened on the next working day.
8. The Managing Director can increase/decrease the quantity of scrap material as per availability of the scrap material.
9. Negotiations, if required, will be held with the H-1 party at the discretion of the Managing Director.
10. In case any tenderer who has participated in the tender, withdrew his tender offer being innocent/ ignorant with regard to any of the terms and conditions of the tender document, in that event, the earnest money deposited with the tender, shall stand forfeited and will not be refunded.
11. In case, the scrap material available / lying at both the plants is not lifted as per the schedule given by both the Plant Managers, the undersigned reserves the right to withhold the payment, cancel the contract. In case, any expenditure / expenses is occurred on alternate sources necessitated due to failure of lifting of scrap material by the scrap vendor, the amount of difference of lifting of scrap material shall be recoverable from the scrap vendors.

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12. 100% advance payments is required before lifting of scrap material of corrugated boxes.
13. The scrap vendor should not have been blacklisted by any Govt. Department, Board, PSU's (Central or State) over India. Hence, the scrap vendor shall submit an affidavit regarding non-blacklisting/ Department on Non-Judicial stamp paper of Rs. 10/-.
14. If any difference of opinion arises between the Corporation and the scrap vendor on the terms and conditions of the tender document, the decision of the Managing Director of the Corporation shall be final and binding on both the parties.
15. All disputes arising between the parties as to the interpretation, operation or affect of any clause of this tender document or any other differences arising between the scrap vendor and the Corporation, which cannot be mutually resolved shall be referred to the arbitration of Administrative Secretary (Industries), Govt. of HP by the party in writing, as per the provision under Arbitration & Reconciliation Act 1996 and as amended from time to time. The decision of such an Arbitrator shall be binding on both the parties.
16. All disputes shall be settled within the jurisdiction of Courts at Shimla only.
